Request for Proposals

Selection Criteria: This Juneau Community Foundation grant is open to any 501(c)3 charitable organization located in Juneau, Alaska, in need of funding programs beneficial to Juneau youth, ages 5-18 years, in sports and activities. JCF will be distributing \$10,000 in grant funds. Suggested grant request is in the \$250-\$2,500 range.

Preference in grant awards will be made for:

- Sports and youth activities that are school-based or community-based for periods during school, after school, or during the summer.
- Supplies and equipment (art supplies, tools, athletic equipment, musical instruments, books, and media equipment used to supplement existing programs).
- Projects/expenditures that will be made within six months of grant award.
- Funding for the last piece of a matching grant which is consistent with above preferences.
- Projects that assist the greatest number of youth over the longest period of time, thereby having the greatest impact.
- Travel, but will not be given high preference.

Grant money will not be awarded for:

- Personnel costs.
- Administrative overhead.
- Expenses that are part of ordinary and customary functions of the organization.
- Church-sponsored activities or projects.

Review Process

The Juneau Community Foundation may ask to meet with representatives of the applicant organization to answer questions about the application or for a site visit. Recommendations for funding will be brought to the JCF's Board for approval. Grant awards will be made no later than Dec 15, 2010.

Note: Grantees must provide a report to JCF describing how the grant was used, within 12 months of grant award.

Deadlines & Submission Information

The application must be submitted by November 19, 2010.
