Foundation for End of Life Care Aids Hospice

Juneau's Foundation for End of Life Care awarded a grant to Hospice and Home Care of Juneau for continued education of HHCJ employees and professional staff. The Foundation for End of Life Care supports hospice care, bereavement services, and community education about end-of-life issues.

The grant will enable HHCJ staff to attend out-of-state conferences, plus receive on-site and first-hand information and education about complex regulatory issues, as well as clinical updates and instruction on new medical technology for managing patient care.

The Foundation for End of Life Care grant funds are invested through the Juneau Community Foundation to support hospice needs and broaden understanding throughout the community about the importance of end of life planning and care options.
